and upon investigation of the essential facts concerning the circumstances of the death and history of the case,

I am of the opinion that the cause of death was Suffocation by sand.

Excavation caved in -- Acc.

The 27th Pct. reports that while working in an excavation, on a sewer, in front of 656 E.223rd Str., he was buried beneath a quantity of sand and rock, which resulted from a cave-in at that place. The body was removed to Fordham Morgue for autopsy.

Autopsy performed at Fordham Morgue, March 21, 1925, at 1:15 P.M.

The body is that of an adult white male, apparently 39 years of age. Eyes suffused. Face cyanosed. Anterior and posterior surface of the body, from the nipples upward, including the neck, markedly cyanosed. No marks of external violence.

The thoracic organs removed en bloc. The lungs are greatly distended, completely filling the pleural cavities. On section they drip dark fluid blood, and show a considerable quantity of oedema.

Mucus membrane of the trachea and larynx violet blue in color. Free hemorrhages are present in the connective tissue around the larynx and oesophagus. A quantity of fine sand, mixed with mucus, is present in the trachea.

Other organs negative.
